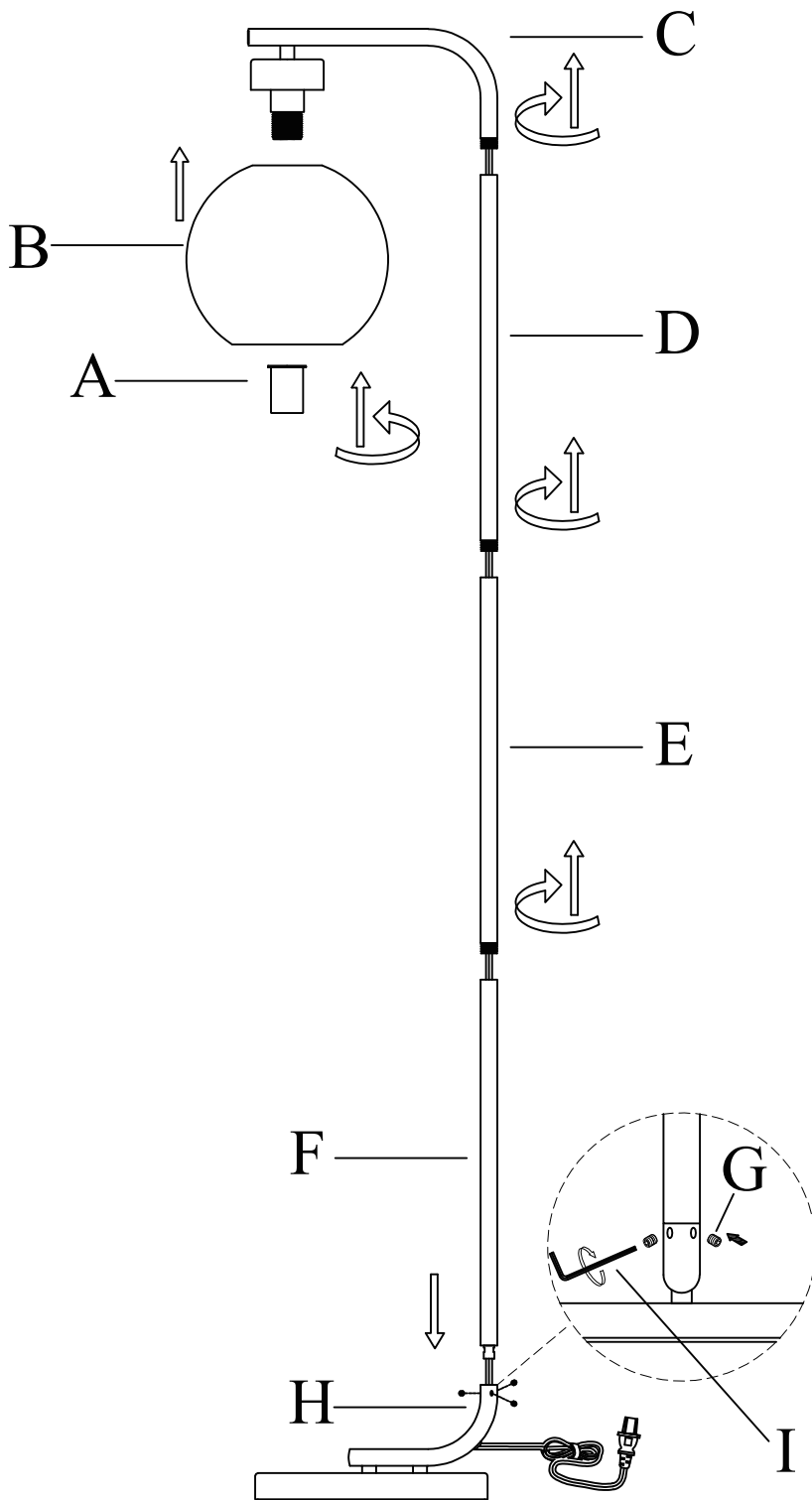


# ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS FOR Atticus Floor Lamp

Model # 3898-01

1. Remove all parts and lay on a flat surface.
2. Screw the pole(D) clockwise into the socket part(C) to tighten.
3. Screw the pole(E) clockwise into the pole(D) to tighten.
4. Screw pole(F) clockwise into the pole(E) to tighten and get the remaining slack of the power cord out carefully from the pole(H).
5. Screws( G) are pre-insert into the pole(H), before insert the pole(F) into the pole(H), please unscrew the screws(G) by using the allen wrench(I).
6. Insert the pole(F) into the pole(H) then use the allen wrench(I) to tighten the screws(G) to secure the pole(F) into the pole(H) . Be sure the lamp is facing the right direction with the arched arm hanging over the base.
7. Socket ring (A) comes pre-assembled to the socket. Before assembling the shade, please unscrew this socket ring (A). Set shade (B) onto socket and tighten clockwise with socket ring (A) to secure shade.

## IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS:

This portable lamp has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other) as a feature to reduce the risk of electric shock. This plug will fit in a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit fully in the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. Never use with an extension cord unless plug can be fully inserted. **DO NOT ALTER THE PLUG.**
